- Sensex rebounds over 1700 points to reclaim 58K, Nifty ends above 17300.**
- Indian equities rebounded on Tuesday, with gains largely led by IT, FMCG, auto, bank stocks. Reports of Russia sending back some troops from Ukraine helped. Sensex moved from between 56,438.47 and 58,211.38, while Nifty traded in the range of 16,839.25-17,375.00
- European stocks and U.S. futures rose Tuesday after a report fuelled optimism that Russia is de-escalating tensions with Ukraine. Russia said Tuesday that some forces deployed near Ukraine were beginning to return to their bases, after a build-up of Moscow's army around Ukrainian borders spurred fears of an invasion.
- After a bruising sell-off on Monday, Indian equities rebounded today to close higher, aided by reports of some de-escalation in tensions between Russia and Ukraine. On the Nifty, Tata Motors, Eicher Motors, Bajaj Finance, Shree Cements and Hero MotorCorp were the top gainers, while Cipla and ONGC were worst hit. Forty eight of 50 Nifty stocks closed higher.

All sectoral indices ended higher, with auto, realty, IT, FMCG stocks, banks, PSU banks up 2-4%. BSE MidCap and SmallCap indices rose 2% each.
